for OHA / ‘Sugar’  
and other bait feed-  
ing ants.**

NORMAL PREPARATION MAY TAKE BETWEEN 1 TO 2 HOURS FOR THE AVERAGE HOME

---

**First:**

Follow all the steps outlined on the OHA Bait - prep sheet.

**Prior to our arrival and treatment:**

Clear small items and clutter away from the base of walls in kitchens, dining rooms, pantries, washrooms, bathrooms, sliding glass doors, and any area with moisture, and / or trash or recycling. Don't worry about large pieces of furniture such as bookcases, etc...

Additionally, clear any other rooms where you see ant activity in the same manner.

Remove items from under your sinks.

Clear kitchen counters. Put away any open food—including pet food.

Be ready to have all people and pets out of the home when we arrive.

**NOTE:**

We ask people to leave the home when we spray on the inside for liability reasons. The materials we apply are applied according to their EPA registered labels and are much less toxic than many common household cleansers. They have no fume, odor, or vapor.

However, we care for our customers, and we want them to be as safe as they possibly can be. Most people will be able to re-enter the treated areas a few short hours after we treat. The materials will be completely dry. You should not be able to smell or see any signs of our materials.

You should begin to see good results within the first week, but for best results your home will need a follow up inspection and baiting after two weeks. We recommend that your home is once again prepared for a follow-up spray when we return, just in case we need so re-spray.
